It is that time of the year when companies have to evaluate their profit margins, tax calculations and B-BBEE scorecards. Spoudazo Enterprises Trust offers the opportunity for entities to earn B-BBEE points by investing a mere 1% of their annual net profit after tax on any of Spoudazo's Socio-economic Development (SED) projects. This investment can be made either in time, services or monetary contributions.

SED is one of the five elements on the B-BBEE scorecard. SED focus on the extent to which an organization carries out initiatives intended to uplift the previously disadvantaged society of South-Africa (who currently still falls outside of the minimum income bracket). Companies could benefit immensely by channelling investment towards Spoudazo's SED initiatives - not only by earning valuable B-BBEE points, but also from a tax- and marketing perspective.

We also offer enterprise development opportunities. Aside from helping to set up businesses and alleviate unemployment, there are significant tax benefits and B-BBEE scorecard points that may be earned by companies investing in the enterprise development. All contributors will be furnished with the required documentation that will enable you to claim points on your B-BBEE scorecard for your ED contribution.

Their daycare service is to provide a loving, safe and stimulating care centre for individuals living with disabilities

and their families. They strive to develop independent and appropriate social behavior and integration. The aim is to develop well balanced and happy individuals living with disabilities, who can be participating members of the broader community.

Tjhabelang Primary School

Tjhabelang Primary School is an English-medium, independent school that aims to provide underprivileged children living in the rural Bainsvlei community, with a pathway out of poverty. At Tjhabelang they strongly believe that social healing can be achieved through early intervention and the provision of a meaningful education. They manage an

appropriate early childhood development programme aimed at laying a solid foundation for a love of life-long learning.



Elanja Children's Initiative

Elanja Children's Initiative was founded in 1999 and has the aim to meet the daily needs of about 200 underprivileged children in Heidedal, Bloemfontein, South Africa. Elanja is in essence a community development project which aims to create a better future for children orphaned by AIDS and those who are abused and neglected. Elanja's efforts are specifically about caring for the physical, emotional and

spiritual needs of these children. Their mission is working to meet the daily needs of all the children involved in the project and to let them know that they are valuable and that someone does care.



Bloemshelter

Recently, Spoudazo Enterprises has included the Bloemshelter as one of our SED projects, especially after the sudden death of the beloved, Izak Botes, whose passion it was to support and equip the homeless.

The Bloemshelter is a faith-based organization that provides care and shelter for homeless men, women, and families, the elderly and other vulnerable persons. They care for the homeless, abused and people who are being socially excluded. Their program, *Pathway to Holistic Development*, provides for an exit strategy, where they facilitate participants to create their own jobs. *Celebrate Recovery* is one of their main pillars, providing for spiritual growth and emotional healing, addressing the hurts and habits of vulnerable people. At the Bloemshelter, personal growth of each individual is what they strive for.

In essence, Spoudazo combines thinking, acting, planning and producing. The word covers inception, action and follow-through.
